

Treasure Valley NAACP General Scholarship Application

Scholarship criteria

Students must:

1. Be seniors enrolled in an Idaho high school located in the Treasure Valley (e.g. Ada, Canyon, Elmore, Gem and Owyhee Counties) or college students enrolled in a higher education institute.
2. Hold a Grade Point Average of 2.75 or higher (on a 4.0 scale)
3. Be interested in pursuing degree at a four-year college or university.
4. Submit a scholarship application to the Treasure Valley Scholarship Committee no later than **March 31, 2007**.

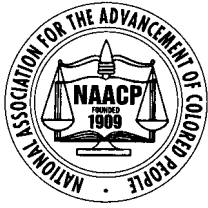
The application must contain the following:

- Student's official high school or college transcript, with Grade Point Average of 2.75 (on a 4.0 scale).
- Letter of recommendation(s) from High School Principal, Counselor, Teacher, Clergy, college academic advisor, or other prominent person(s), in the student's community.
- A letter from the student seeking the scholarship, addressed to the Treasure Valley NAACP Scholarship Committee. The letter should concentrate on the following criteria:
 - An introduction describing the student, whom the committee is considering.
 - Statements indicating why the student is deserving of the scholarship.
 - A narrative explaining the student's community involvement and role within his/her family.
 - Any awards that the student may have earned while in high school or college.
 - Where the student plans to attend college (or which college or institute they currently attend), and what they plan to study.
 - Student's future academic/career goals
 - Closing explanation as to how the student plans to make his or her community better once they finish their educational requirements.

The Scholarship Committee will use the above information to award the scholarships. Once the selection is completed and validated, all monies for the scholarship will be written paid jointly to the student and the school she/he plans to attend and forwarded directly to the Registrar's office or to their parents.
